Hello Everyone,

The Webster Walks are already being arranged for this year. This is our 11th year of fundraising and this year we will be donating funds to Phase 4 of the Lawrence and McLaren Donkey Hospital at Island Farm Donkey Sanctuary, Brightwell-cum-Sotwell, Wallingford, Oxon. OX10 0SW. Phase 4 is to acquire vital pieces of equipment including a sterilising unit and diagnostic equipment in order to enable veterinary surgeons to treat resident and visiting donkeys and small ponies.

Contributing to the Webster Fund does not have to be only from the proceeds of a Sponsored Walk – though this has proved to be a very enjoyable and lovely activity resulting in many happy memories. Donations can be raised for example from selling unwanted donkey gear or bric-a-brac, second hand books, hand-printed cards, collections at coffee mornings and talks, anything at all. 5th May - Donkey Dentistry and the Prevention of health problems. Explanations and demonstrations by Donkey Sanctuary Dental Technicians Lee Gosden and Gemma Lilly, plus a talk on how to prevent general health issues, including worming, vaccinations, feeding, foot care etc. by Sanctuary Welfare Officer, Georgia McCormick. Gemma will give a Talk on the care of donkeys' teeth, the prevention of problems related to the teeth and how to spot the signs your donkey's teeth may be causing unnecessary pain or discomfort. Lee and Gemma will treat at least four donkeys and two mules, explaining what they are doing and answering any questions and queries. Would you like to bring your own donkey to have a dental examination? There is no charge for a check-up but there is a charge of £50 if you wish to have your donkey treated by Lee or Gemma. The booklet on Donkey Dentistry produced by the Donkey Breed Society and the Donkey Sanctuary will be available.

Location: Claire Harper's home at Orchard View, West Side, North Littleton, Near Evesham, Worcestershire, WR11 8QP. Coffee and registration at 10.00am for a 10.30am start of the first lecture. Please bring your own picnic lunch but tea and coffee will be available at all times. Finishing time approximately 4.00pm. Cost for the day is £5 (children free) but there is no admission charge if you are bringing a donkey. Dental care of the donkey is a really vital, but often ignored, part of keeping donkeys healthy. From early days to old age the teeth can cause huge problems and often owners are not aware of what is happening. Everyone is welcome, membership of the DBS is not necessary, so please do bring friends and relatives, or anyone interested in equine dentistry. Please let Claire Harper know if you are intending to participate, with or without your own donkeys and mules.
