Field signs could save your donkey's life... users of social media will recently have seen distressing photos of equines that have died needlessly due to being fed by the public and with an increase in folk taking exercise in the countryside, so too the terrible risk of losing our precious animals has increased. Signage is an incredibly positive and relatively inexpensive way forward and, after all, what price wouldn't you put on your animals' safety?



The British Horse Society's 'Be Horse Aware' campaign is extremely helpful and has free downloadable signs and if you visit their shop you will also find plastic signage with predrilled holes for easy display.

Perhaps we can create our own Donkey Aware posters and signs, for display in the Northern Region?
